# 2025-2026 Sunday School Treasure Map Information

Year Theme: Treasuring God's Word

Year Theme Verse: Luke 12:34

"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

## How it works:

Each student in Sunday School has their very own Treasure Map!

- The contents, or "treasures", of the Treasure Map are:
  - Luke 12:34
  - Ephesians 2:8
  - John 3:16
  - Apostle's Creed
  - Lord's Prayer
  - 10 Commandments
  - Books of the Old Testament
  - Books of the New Testament
- On any Sunday that there is Sunday School, a student can ask to recite one of the "treasures" above to their Sunday School teacher.
- Students are only allowed to recite one "treasure" on any given Sunday and cannot recite multiple "treasures" (i.e. they cannot recite the 10 Commandments and the Books of the Old Testament in one day).
- Some "treasures" are split into sections to make them easier to learn. Students can choose to only recite one section of a "treasure" if they so choose, or they can choose to recite the entirety of one "treasure".
- When a student successfully recites one of the "treasures" (or a section of a "treasure", they will receive a gem sticker to put on that particular spot to mark it as completed.
- "Treasures" can be recited in any order.
- When a student successfully recites all "treasures" on their Treasure Map\*, they will receive a
  free meal at Culver's and one item of their choosing (any price) from the Sunday School
  Store (excluding gift cards)!
  - \*PreK3, PreK4 and Kindergarten students need to complete at least 5 "treasures" on their map for it to be considered completed. They may skip two "treasures".
- The "treasures" on the Treasure Map can become a part of your family devotions/bedtime prayer time or can be practiced in the car...whatever works best for your family!
